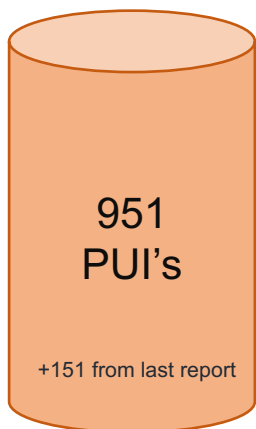


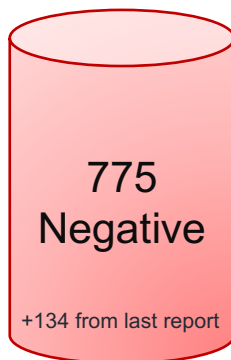

## COVID-19 Trends

We will be working diligently to get the latest statistics regarding COVID-19 patients. Below are this week's newest numbers, (the last report sent out was on May 29 for reference).



We have had a total of 951 patients under investigation (PUIs)



775 patients tested **NEGATIVE** for COVID-19



176 patients tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19  
**\*48 were seen & discharged through the ED**



Of the 176 positive cases, **126** were admitted.



Out of the 126 admitted patients, 121 were discharged and 5 remain in-house.

As we move into Stage 2 of the re-opening of our city, it is important to remember our essential role in protecting ourselves, our patients, and our families. The threat of COVID-19 remains; diligent practices continue, wearing a mask in all patient care areas or areas of close contact with others.
