

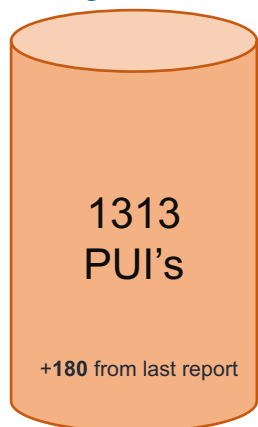

COVID-19 Trends

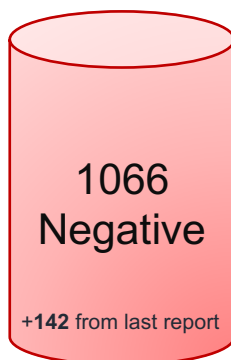

We have had a total of 1313 patients under investigation (PUIs)



1066 patients tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19



247 patients tested POSITIVE for COVID-19  
**\*86 were seen & discharged through the ED**



Of the 247 positive cases, 161 were admitted.



Out of the 161 admitted patients, 145 were discharged and 16 remain in-house.



A few hospital reminders as we continue with COVID-19.

- We will continue to monitor for fever at hospital entrances.
- Visitor restrictions still remain and all exceptions should go through house supervisor.
- Surgical Masks are still required at all times within the hospital, this includes cafeteria and office space where social distancing cannot be achieved. N95s are required in all COVID designated areas and when caring for a patient.
- All in house codes should be responded to with full PPE, N95, goggles and gown regardless if patient is COVID or Non-COVID.
- Isolating the patient as soon as recognized as potential COVID is mandatory.
- Strict handwashing is required at all times.
